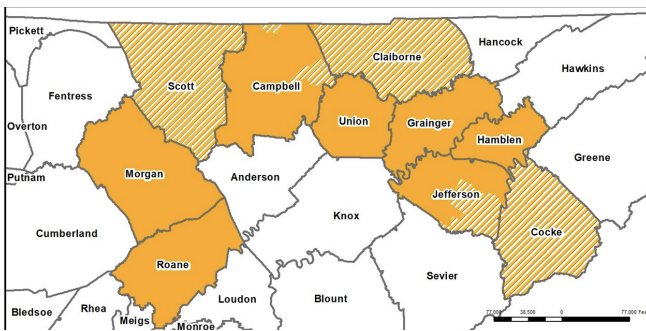
Rural Communities Opioid Response Program - East Tennessee Consortium

ABOUT US

RCORP-ETC is a collaborative effort to reduce the opioid epidemic in East TN through a community-engaged approach.

RCORP-ETC serves to solve the opioid epidemic in East Tennessee by enhancing the quantity and quality OUD resources, provider services, and community supports that promote OUD prevention, treatment, and recovery.

The RCORP-ETC membership includes over 100 professionals from 30 organizations that serve the East Tennessee RCORP-ETC area.



Our top priorities include: (a) mental health promotion and treatment, (b) stigma reduction, and (c) increased number and quality of treatment and recovery services.

RCORP-ETC meets quarterly and currently has three working groups that focus on OUD resources for youth, providers, and the greater community. Working groups meet monthly.
